5. In no case may more than 1 adult or 2 children under 10 years of age be buried in one plot.

- 6. Such fees, not exceeding \$5 as may be fixed from time to time by the Administrator, Petaling Jaya, with the approval of the Ruler in Council, shall be paid for every burial, with the exception of the burial of persons who die possessed of no property or who have no relations or friends able to pay.
- 7. The fee for the use of the motor-hearse shall be \$15 for the first 12 miles and \$1 for every subsequent mile.
 - 8. There shall be no reservations of plots for burial.
 - 9. All fees shall be paid to the Administrator, Petaling Jaya.
- 10. The Administrator shall keep a register showing the name, age and sex, the last place of residence, cause of death and date of burial of each person buried in the cemetery according to the number of the plot wherein such person is buried.

PETALING JAYA (CHRISTIAN CEMETERY) RULES, 1960

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 9 of the Burials F.M.S. Enactment, the Ruler in Council hereby makes the following Rules:

- 1. These Rules may be cited as the Petaling Jaya (Christian Citation. Cemetery) Rules, 1960.
- 2. The charge of the Cemetery shall be vested in the Administrator, Petaling Jaya.
 - 3. The Cemetery shall be divided into plots for graves.
- 4. Such plots shall be numbered consecutively and marked on a plan, which shall be kept at the Office of the Administrator, Petaling Jaya.
- 5. The size of each plot shall be 10 ft. in length by 5 ft. in width, and all graves shall be dug to a depth not less than 6 ft. below the surface of the ground.
- 6. Not more than one adult or two children under 10 years of age may be buried in one plot. Provided that exemption from the operation of this rule may be granted by the Administrator at his discretion in special cases after reference to the Health Officer for the District and subject to any reasonable directions that may be issued by the Health Officer for the purpose of preventing danger to the public health.
- 7. The following fees will be charged for interments and permission to erect memorials, etc:

For each interment (to include the cost of opening and	i
filling up the grave)	\$10.00
For use of motor-hearse (for the first 12 miles	15.00
(and for every subsequent mile)	1.00
For permission to erect a cross or other simple memo-	
rial of wood or other perishable material	1.00
For permission to erect a cross, headstone, railing, slab,	
or other memorial of a permanent nature	5.00
For setting apart one or more contiguous plots for the	
burial of any person or of any member of his family	
for each plot /	25.00

The Administrator on a certificate by the Minister of the Religion of the deceased that the deceased has left no estate, nor any relative or friends of sufficient means to pay the prescribed fees, may remit the whole or any part thereof.

- 8. The plans of all memorials, or enclosures must be submitted to the Administrator for approval before erection.
- 9. The Administrator shall keep and maintain the Cemetery in good order and condition and shall appoint, a caretaker who shall arrange for the digging of graves and the maintenance of grounds and memorials.
- 10. The Administrator shall keep a register showing the name, age and sex, the last place of residence, cause of death and date of burial of each person buried in the cemetery according to the number of his plot wherein such person is buried.
